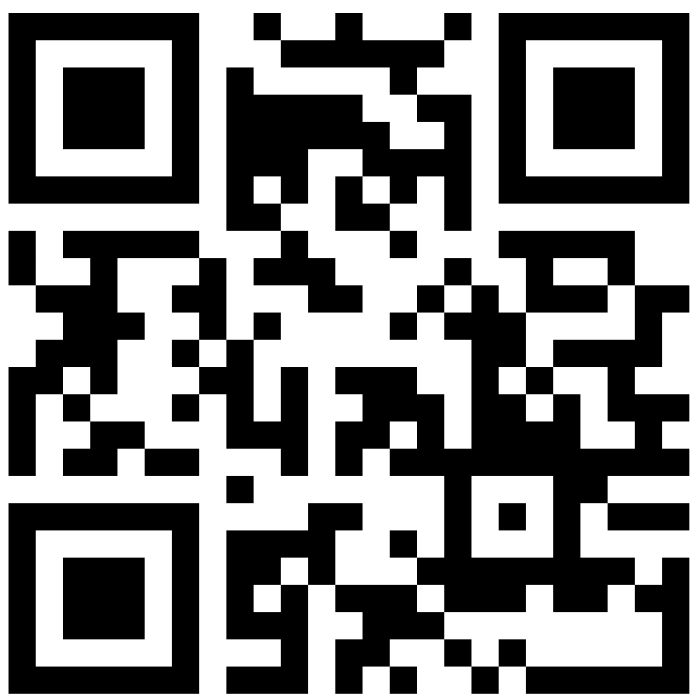

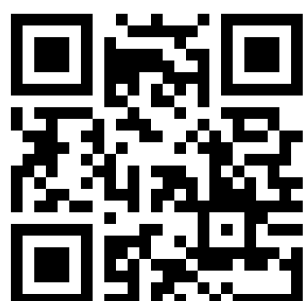
1 Visit golocal.cmucsp.org or scan the QR code at the bottom
